

RESOLUTION NO. R25-66**A RESOLUTION BY THE TROTWOOD CITY COUNCIL
ADOPTING THE REVISED CITY OF TROTWOOD PUBLIC
RECORDS POLICY.**

WHEREAS, Section 149.43(E)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code requires all public offices to adopt a public records policy in accordance with Section 149.43 of the Ohio Revised Code, known as the Ohio Public Records Act, for responding to public records requests; and

WHEREAS, the City's current public records policy was adopted by City Council on November 5, 2024, Resolution No. R24-95; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the Ohio Public Records Act and to make needed updates to the City's official Public Records Policy due to recent changes to public records law allowing a fee to be charged for requests for video records to offset the significant labor and cost involved in the required review and redaction of content, it is in the best interest of the public to adopt a revised Public Records Policy.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION I: The Trotwood City Council hereby adopts the revised City of Trotwood Public Records Policy attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION II: All previous versions of the City of Trotwood's Public Records Policy are replaced by the attached policy.

SECTION III: A copy of the revised Public Records Policy shall be posted in an area accessible by the public.

SECTION IV: This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its passage.
