OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITY OF CENTRAL STATE UNIVERSITY:

- CSU, through its Cooperative Extension Service shall coordinate opportunities, collaborations and/or expansion of 4-H Youth Development programs in the City.
- CSU shall coordinate educational seminars on various topics relating to agriculture, engineering, and scholarship opportunities within the City.
- CSU shall promote agricultural and natural resources opportunities within the City.
- CSU shall maintain a satellite office in the City of Trotwood through a lease agreement with the City.
- CSU shall work closely with City leaders to promote the programs Central State University offers.
- CSU shall coordinate opportunities for Family and Consumer Sciences within the City.
- CSU shall work with and coordinate with the City leadership team to promote opportunities for Community and Economic Development programs through the USDA's Rural Development Agency and other programs related to economic development.
- CSU shall work with the City toward collaborative grants to support joint programming.
- CSU shall provide, at its sole cost, computer hardware for staff employed by CSU for the Extension Program office that is located within the City. Software costs, internet and telephone connection fees, and other costs including, but not limited to utilities, for the Extension Program office within the City shall be paid by CSU at its sole cost.
- In promoting the partnership between CSU and the City, each entity will display their signage together where appropriate.
- CSU shall help coordinate a small farmer's education center for minority and women in the City.
