- ✓ Position T44 as the leading program for Trotwood youth to develop outdoor survival skills, self-confidence, and ethical values



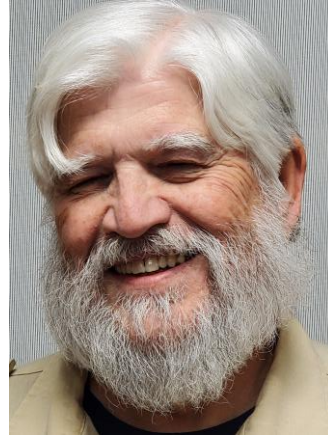

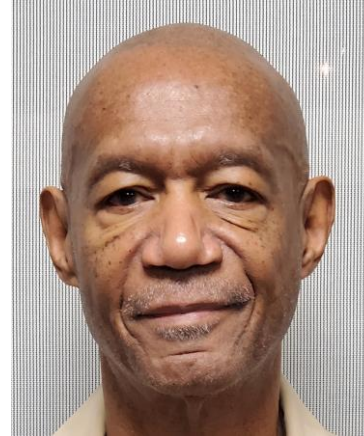

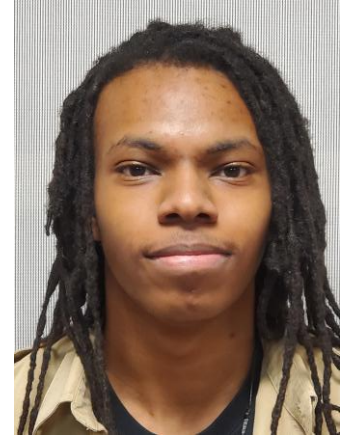

- **Boy Scouts of America** a national youth organization **established 1918** to help boys (**11-17 yrs old**) develop outdoor survival skills, self-confidence, and ethics.
- **Troop 44 (T44) chartered 1923 (102 years)**
- **50+ scouts achieved the rank of Eagle Scout**
- **135+ Merit badges** (Camping; Cooking; Sports; Communication; Citizenship in the Community, Nation, Society, World; Personal Management, just to name a few)
- **Elected youth lead their troop, run meeting at the guidance of Scoutmaster and other adult leaders.**
