Connecting unemployed adults with training and services to help them find jobs to enter and return to the local workforce.




Impact

Citizens all over Montgomery County need Human Services, and the Human Services Renewal Levy is a necessity.


Without it, \$58 million in critical, local funding for Montgomery County will be lost – and millions more in federal and state funding will disappear.

Human Services Help Every Montgomery County Community!




Suburban Services = 49% / Central Services = 51%



Spending

Spending on Human Services is reviewed regularly by the Human Services Levy Council (HSLC), which includes local, independent business leaders, financial experts, and citizen volunteers. The HSLC helps ensure we control costs, decide on priorities, and do our best to meet critical needs.

Human Services Levy Funding of \$137.9 million helps secure total budgets of \$211.5 million for a variety of community-based human services needs (as outlined to the right).
