WHAT IS A SCREENING MAMMOGRAM

- A screening mammogram is a simple exam where X-ray images are taken of your breast.
- It is the single most effective way to detect breast cancer at its earliest stage, before symptoms are present and while the cancer is still treatable.







MOBILE MAMMOGRAPHY

- Provides onsite screenings at your facility
- Open to patients, staff and community
- Offers 2D and 3D Tomosynthesis mammograms
- Same equipment, technologist and physicians that provide care at UC Medical Center and West Chester Hospital








TYPES OF MAMMOGRAMS

2D:

Flat 2D digital image of the breast

3D/Tomosynthesis:

- Higher quality imaging by providing 1 millimeter ۲ slices throughout the breast in addition to 2D imaging
- Radiation dosage is similar and difference in time is seconds
- Reduces number of call backs as it allows radiologist • to see areas that may otherwise be in question with a 2D mammogram









TARGET AUDIENCE

- Baseline Screening: Women 35-39
- Annual Screening: Women 40 and over
