

ORDINANCE NO. OR22-16

AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF TROTWOOD FOR THE AUTHORIZATION TO RENAME MODERN WAY TO STRATACACHE WAY WHICH CONNECTS TO OLIVE ROAD SOUTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF WOLF CREEK PIKE AND OLIVE ROAD IN THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is necessary to rename Modern Way to Stratacache Way which connects to Olive Road south of the intersection of Wolf Creek Pike and Olive Road to address the acquisition by Stratacache Inc. of a 378,000 square foot facility in the City's Industrial Park; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determines that renaming Modern Way to Stratacache way will not create any confusion or be detrimental to providing public resources or detrimental to the public; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorizes the renaming of Modern Way to Stratacache Way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I: City Council of Trotwood hereby authorizes the City Manager to take all actions necessary to rename Modern Way to Stratacache Way which connects to Olive Road east of the intersection of Wolf Creek Pike and Olive Road.

SECTION II: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including, but not limited to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency in order to support the acquisition of a 378,000 square foot facility in the City's Industrial Park by Stratacache Inc., which will economically benefit the City and its citizens. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
