

RESOLUTION NO. 17-13

A RESOLUTION BY THE TROTWOOD CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR THE RENEWAL OF THE MUNICIPAL BRIDGE INSPECTION SERVICES, KNOWN AS THE STATEWIDE MUNICIPAL BRIDGE INSPECTION PROGRAM 2, PID NO. 102554, IN THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Project Manager recommend that the City of Trotwood enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation to renew the Municipal Bridge Inspection Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Trotwood desires to enter into this agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation to ensure the safety of the bridges in the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I: The Council for the City of Trotwood hereby finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Trotwood to enter into an updated agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation to renew the Municipal Bridge Inspection Program and hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an updated agreement for the Municipal Bridge Inspection Program.

SECTION II: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into the updated Municipal Bridge Inspection Program Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" in the same or substantially similar form.

SECTION III: This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its passage.
