

RESOLUTION NO. 17-83

**A RESOLUTION BY TROTWOOD CITY COUNCIL DECLARING
CERTAIN PUBLIC WORKS VEHICLES AS OBSOLETE AND NO
LONGER NEEDED FOR A PUBLIC PURPOSE AND AUTHORIZING
SAID PROPERTY FROM THE TROTWOOD PUBLIC WORKS
DEPARTMENT TO BE DECLARED SCRAP AND SOLD**

WHEREAS, the Public Works Project Manager has determined that certain equipment of the Trotwood Public Works Department is no longer being utilized due to damage and has become obsolete; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Project Manager has requested these obsolete items be declared scrap; and

WHEREAS, the obsolete equipment is fully set forth in the document attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends Council declare the items obsolete and no longer needed for a public purpose and authorize the items set forth on the attached Exhibit "A" be sold as scrap.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

SECTION I: Council hereby finds and determines that the property listed in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein is obsolete and is no longer needed for municipal purposes.

SECTION II: The City Manager is hereby authorized to have the property listed in the attached Exhibit "A" sold be sold as scrap.

SECTION III: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage.
