

RESOLUTION NO. R18-102

**A RESOLUTION BY THE TROTWOOD CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, OHIO AND THE
OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION FOR THE PERIOD
OF JANUARY 1, 2019 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2021**

WHEREAS, the current Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association has expired; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association have engaged in negotiations and agreement has been reached for a new 3-year Collective Bargaining Agreement for the period of January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and Human Resources Director recommend City Council authorize the City Manager to sign, on behalf of the City, the Contract with the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association .

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

SECTION 1: Council hereby accepts the terms as negotiated and the recommendation that these terms be accepted and authorizes the City Manager to execute on behalf of the City, the Collective Bargaining Agreement, incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
