

ORDINANCE NO. OR27-18

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING OLD CHAPTER 931 “SMALL CELL FACILITIES & WIRELESS SUPPORT STRUCTURES” OF THE CITY OF TROTWOOD CODE OF ORDINANCES AS ADOPTED ON OCTOBER 1, 2018

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2018 by way of OR22-18, Council adopted New Chapter 931 of the City of Trotwood Code of Codified Ordinances regarding the regulation of small cell facilities, wireless facilities, and wireless support structures; and

WHEREAS, the adopted OR22-18 contains inadvertent errors including but not limited to, pages being omitted and the inclusion of internal comments not meant to be a part of Chapter 931; and

WHEREAS, Counsel seeks to repeal Chapter 931 in its entirety due to the included errors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION I.

Chapter 931 (“Small Cell Facilities & Wireless Support Structures”) of the City of Trotwood Code of Codified Ordinances as adopted on October 1, 2018, be repealed in its entirety including all sections therein.

SECTION II.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including, but not limited to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III.

This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
