Re: Disposal of unserviceable Police vehicles

Chief Wilson,

The Fleet Manager (Officer G. Bowerman) submitted a request to dispose of certain City vehicles, assigned to the Trotwood Police Department. The conditions of these vehicles are such that they are not in a condition to sell to the public as roadworthy vehicles, (*excessive damage to frames / rusted bodies, brake & fuel lines / excessive mileage / non-working engines & transmissions*) and the costs to bring them up to a roadway level far exceeds the value of each vehicle.

It is my recommendation that these vehicles be sold to a licensed Used Auto Parts dealer, as we have done previously. By doing so in this manner we reduce any potential liability to the City, from unreasonable claims associated with selling these vehicles as roadworthy.

Previous vehicle disposals were done by providing the 3 licensed Used Auto Parts dealers, primarily located within the City of Trotwood, with a list of vehicles that described the overall condition and requested a bid quote. Each dealer provided their quote in the blind in writing.

On Tuesday, August 13, 2019 I met with the General Managers of LKQ Pick Your Part (*Ryan Brunk*), A&B Auto Parts (*Jacque Haynes*) and Grade "A" Auto Parts (*Richard Edwards*), each manager was provided a detailed list of vehicles and pictures. Each manager was requested to provide me with a quote that included their cost to pick up all vehicles. Each dealer returned their bid quote back to me by the close of business on August 13, 2019.



Re: Disposal of Unserviceable Vehicles

Vehicle # 1 (Patrol Vehicle # 709) – 2009 Dodge Charger; **VIN: 2B3KA43T69H519258**; mileage - 200,511 – (All police lights and equipment will be removed). Vehicle starts but has a blown engine. Body is good / fair condition and has been vinyl wrapped blue/yellow. Trotwood Police markings will be removed prior to disposal.

Vehicle # 2 – 2000, Chevy Lumina (black in color), **VIN: 5G1WL52JOY1256264**; mileage – 106310; condition: poor body/frame rusted. All police lights and equipment will be removed. Vehicle starts and runs, tires are fair. Vehicle was used as an unmarked detective vehicle. Vehicle is located in the police department lot.

Vehicle # 3 – 2002, Chevy Avalanche (black in color) – **VIN: 3GNEK13T62G262171**; mileage 264071 – condition fair with rust, noise coming from transfer case. Vehicle starts and runs, tires in poor condition. Vehicle was used as an unmarked detective vehicle. Vehicle located in the police department lot.

Vehicle # 4 – 2003, Buick Century (gold in color); **VIN: 2G4WS52J431255018**; mileage 231,000 (roughly) – poor body/frame rusted (all police lights and equipment will be removed). Vehicle starts and runs, tires are in fair condition. Vehicle was used as an unmarked detective vehicle. Vehicle located in the police department lot.

Vehicle # 5 – 2000, Chevy Lumina (maroon in color); **VIN: 2G1WL52J7Y1254835**; mileage: 122,689 – poor body/frame rusted (all police lights and equipment in good working order will be removed). Vehicle starts and runs, tires are fair. Vehicle was used as an unmarked detective vehicle. Vehicle is located in the public works lot.

Vehicle # 6 – 2000, Chevy Silverado, Pickup Truck, quad cab, 6 foot bed; (white in color); **VIN: 1GCEK19V3YE382012**; mileage: 2224487, body rust (all police lights and equipment will be removed). Transmission problems, tires fair / poor. Vehicle was used

Vehicle # 7 - 1997, Ford Crown Vic; (black in color). VIN: 2FALP71W4VX151071; mileage – 175,806, body condition fair, tires good / fair. Vehicle does start and was used initially as a police vehicle, then converted into an unmarked vehicle. Vehicle parked inside a garage. Interior is in good condition.

Vehicle # 8 (Patrol Vehicle 210) - 2010, Dodge Charger; VIN: 2B3AA4CT4AH161979; mileage – 187,052 (All police lights and equipment will be removed), body condition good/fair, tires good / fair. Vehicle does starts but has a blown engine). Vehicle located at the public works lot. Interior is in good condition. Trotwood Police markings will be removed prior to disposal.

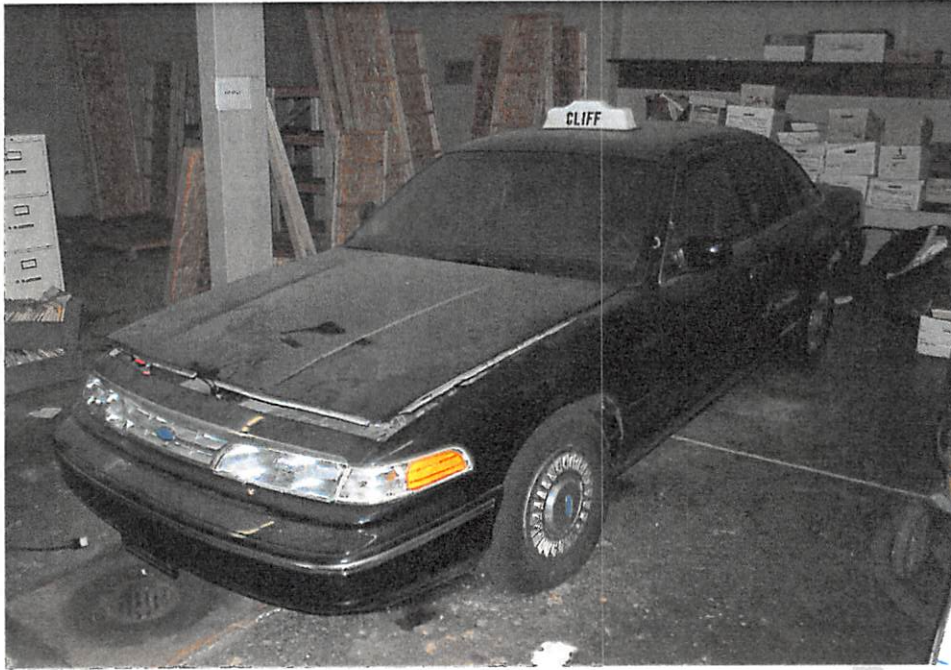

Vehicle does starts and runs. Vehicle located in the police department lot. Interior is in good condition. Trotwood Police markings will be removed prior to disposal.

Vehicle # 10 (Patrol Vehicle 205) - 2005, Ford Crown Vic ; VIN: 2FAFP71W85X179906; mileage – 164,457 (All police lights and equipment will be removed), body condition poor, tires good / fair. Vehicle does starts and runs but needs major engine repair/replacement. Vehicle located in the police department lot. Interior is in good condition. Trotwood Police markings will be removed prior to disposal.
