

RESOLUTION NO. R19-109

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO HAVE THE ANNUAL HARVEST FAMILY FUN WALK SCHEDULED ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2019 TO SERVE THE PUBLIC PURPOSE OF COMMUNITY RELATIONS FOR THE EXPENDITURES NOT TO EXCEED \$1,500.00

SECTION II. City Council hereby authorizes the funding to cover expenses for purchases not to exceed \$1,500.00.
