

RESOLUTION NO. R19-106

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
DECLARE CERTAIN OBSOLETE AND/OR SURPLUS POLICE
VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT AS NO LONGER NEEDED FOR A
PUBLIC PURPOSE AND AUTHORIZING SAID PROPERTY FROM
THE TROTWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT TO BE SOLD TO
LOCAL AUTO SALVAGE COMPANIES.**

WHEREAS, the Police Department Chief has determined that certain vehicles and equipment of the Trotwood Police Department are no longer being utilized due to no longer being serviceable and the cost to maintain to be safe and serviceable exceeds the value; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager found these certain vehicles and equipment belonging to the City are obsolete and/or surplus and are no longer needed for any public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department Chief has requested these obsolete and/or surplus items be sold to local auto salvage companies; and

WHEREAS, the obsolete and/or surplus police vehicles and equipment is fully set forth in the document attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends Council declare the items surplus and authorize the items set forth on the attached Exhibit "A" be sold to local salvage companies.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

SECTION I:

Council hereby finds and determines that the property listed in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein is obsolete and/or surplus and is no longer needed for municipal purposes.

SECTION II:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to have the property listed in the attached Exhibit "A" sold to local auto salvage companies.

SECTION III:

This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage.
