City Manager Quincy E. Pope stated, all funds in the operating 2020 budget is \$22,642,095.00 are 1% below the 2019 levels with this figure, the amount proposed to be spent from the city's four core funds that utilize tax dollars to furnish basic ongoing services is \$14,423,963.00 The proposed General Fund budget of \$8,543,753 is \$309,170 or 3.8% above the 2019 General Fund budget. Projections for the 2020 property tax collections are anticipated to decrease by about 6% due to the devastation caused by the 2019 Memorial Day tornadoes. City Manager reported that the 2020 Budget is balanced. Attached are the various departmental submissions.
