WHEREAS, the Trotwood City Council further recognizes a tree lighting event serves a valid public purpose in that it provides family activities to celebrate the holidays, spreads holiday cheer and goodwill, and improves community relations; and

WHEREAS, the Christmas Tree Lighting Event is a city-sponsored virtual event intended to serve a valid public purpose by providing family activities to celebrate the holidays, spread holiday cheer and goodwill, and maintain strong community relations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I:	The Trotwood City Council determines that a Virtual Christmas Tree Lighting event is a city-sponsored event intended to serve the public purpose of providing family activities to celebrate the holidays, spread holiday cheer and goodwill, and maintain strong community relations.
SECTION II:	The Trotwood City Council hereby authorizes expenditures not to exceed \$2,500.00 for this Virtual Christmas Tree Lighting Event.
SECTION III:	This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its passage.
