**INFORMATION:** Motion: File 21-09, May 3, 2021; The American Rescue Plan Act was signed into law on March 11, 2021, and provides additional relief to address the continued impact of COVID-19 on the economy, public health, state and local governments, individuals, and businesses. Per the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA), separate accountability is required for direct recipients of federal awards greater than \$25,000.
